Psalm 27:13

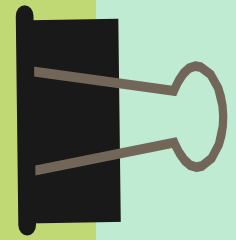
“Let us not grow weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.” Galatians 6:9

Here are the key benefits:

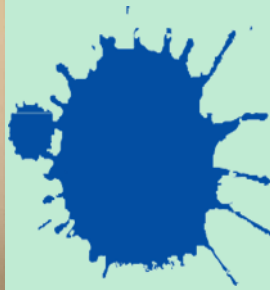
-  1. Develops Fine Motor Skills.
