Thank you for being an important part of our journey.

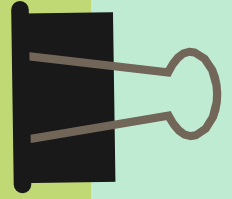

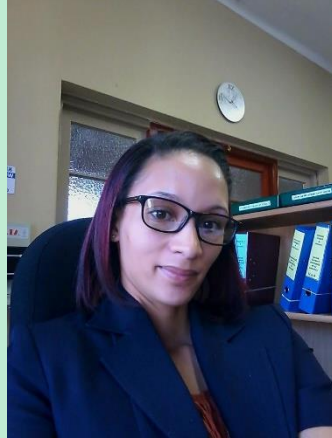

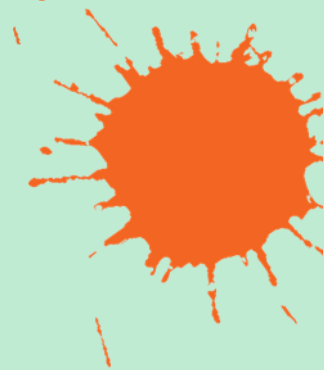

🎨 Visual Arts

- Drawing, painting, coloring
- Collage, clay, playdough
- Using recycled and natural materials

🎵 Music

- Singing songs and rhymes
- Exploring sounds with instruments
- Moving to music and rhythm

👯 Dance & Movement

- Free movement and body expression
- Action songs
- Creative movement games

🎭 Drama & Role Play

- Pretend play (home corner, shops, doctors)
- Story acting and puppets
- Dressing up and imaginative play





HAPPY BIRTHDAY CORNER
