We may not see growth right away. Seeds grow quietly beneath the soil before they ever appear above the ground. But with care, consistency, and faith, growth always comes.

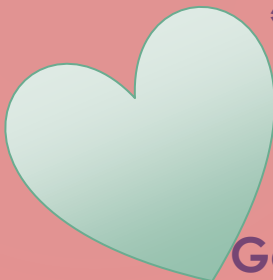
This week, let's ask ourselves:
